- Pat is a Partner at KPMG in the Enterprise Sector which has a focus on family businesses.
- He has a rare experience of having worked in a family business, Central Textiles, from 2005-2014 whilst currently working as a financial professional. Having been on both sides of the fence, he has a unique viewpoint of the needs of a family business and appreciates how financial professionals can help facilitate the challenges that the families and the businesses face in this fast changing environment.
- During his time at Central Textiles, he predominantly focused on taking industry leadership in the area of sustainable development. Through his leadership Central Textiles was the first textile company in Asia to issue a Sustainability Report under the Global Reporting Initiatives (“GRI”) Guidelines in 2008. The report subsequently received an award from the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (“ACCA”).
- Central Textiles also subsequently won the Gold Award for the Hang Seng Pearl River Delta Environmental Award in 2012 and the Gold Award for the Hong Kong Award for Environmental Excellence – Manufacturing Sector in 2013. He also helped KPMG win the HKAAE Silver Award – Service and Trading Sector in 2017.
- For his contribution to the textile industry with regards to sustainability, Pat received the Young Industrialist of the Year award from the Federation of Hong Kong Industries in 2009.
- Pat currently serves on the United Nations Economic & Social Commission for Asia Pacific (UNESCAP) on their Sustainable Business Network Task Force on banking and finance.
- He is also in the market development committee of the Financial Services Development Council (“FSDC”) and chaired their working group on sustainable finance which issued a report in November 2018 on the ESG strategy for Hong Kong.
